


South Australia premier Steve Marshall hosts FCA media trip

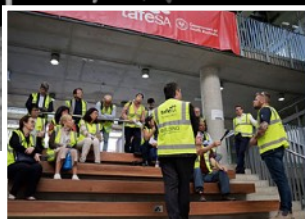

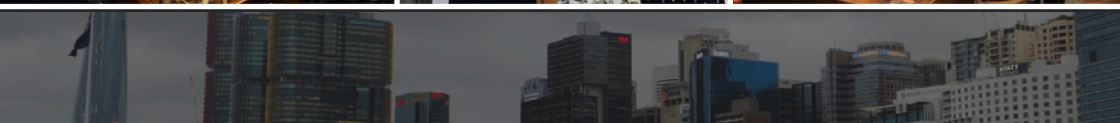

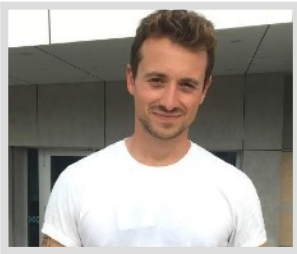

MEDIA STATEMENT - 2019

The recent arrest of French television correspondent Hugo Clément and his crew during filming near Abbot Point in Queensland is of great concern to every working journalist in Australia – including resident foreign correspondents and members of the Foreign Correspondents' Association, Australia & South Pacific (FCA).

As reporting restrictions, government regulations, and decreased access to sources makes it harder for journalists to do their job, the FCA is becoming an important lobby group protecting the interests and rights of foreign correspondents.
